SECTION 3: SUPPORT
<ul> <li>☐ Are resources (human, infrastructure, and environment) available for OHS system?</li> <li>☐ Is there an awareness program for employees regarding ISO 45001?</li> <li>☐ Are documented procedures in place for competence, awareness, and communication?</li> </ul>
SECTION 4: OPERATION
<ul> <li>☐ Are processes determined, documented, and consistently followed?</li> <li>☐ Are criteria for OHS performance, including legal requirements, defined and monitored?</li> <li>☐ Is there a process for identifying actions related to OHS?</li> </ul>
<b>SECTION 5: PERFORMANCE EVALUATION</b>
<ul> <li>☐ Are internal audits conducted to assess OHS management system?</li> <li>☐ Are data and information collected and analyzed to evaluate OHS performance?</li> <li>☐ Is there a process for conducting management reviews?</li> </ul>
SECTION 6: IMPROVEMENT
<ul> <li>☐ Are corrective actions taken when non-conformities are identified?</li> <li>☐ Is there a process for continuous improvement based on OHS performance data?</li> <li>☐ Are preventive actions implemented to address potential OHS issues and risks?</li> </ul>

☐ Are procedures and processes documented as required by ISO 45001?
☐ Are records maintained to demonstrate OHS conformity and effectiveness?
☐ Is document control in place to ensure the latest versions of documents are used?
